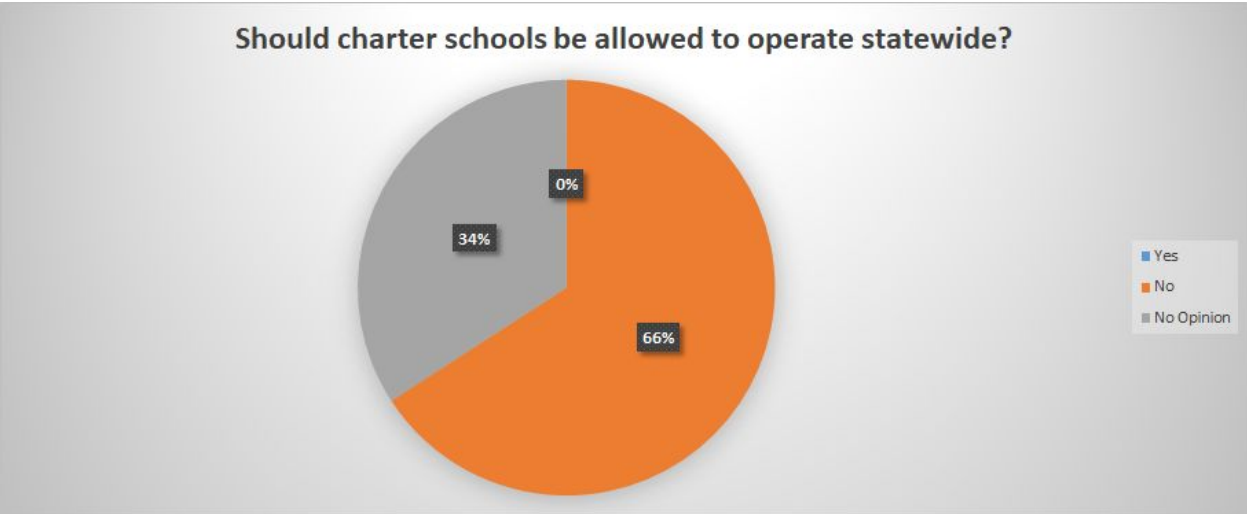
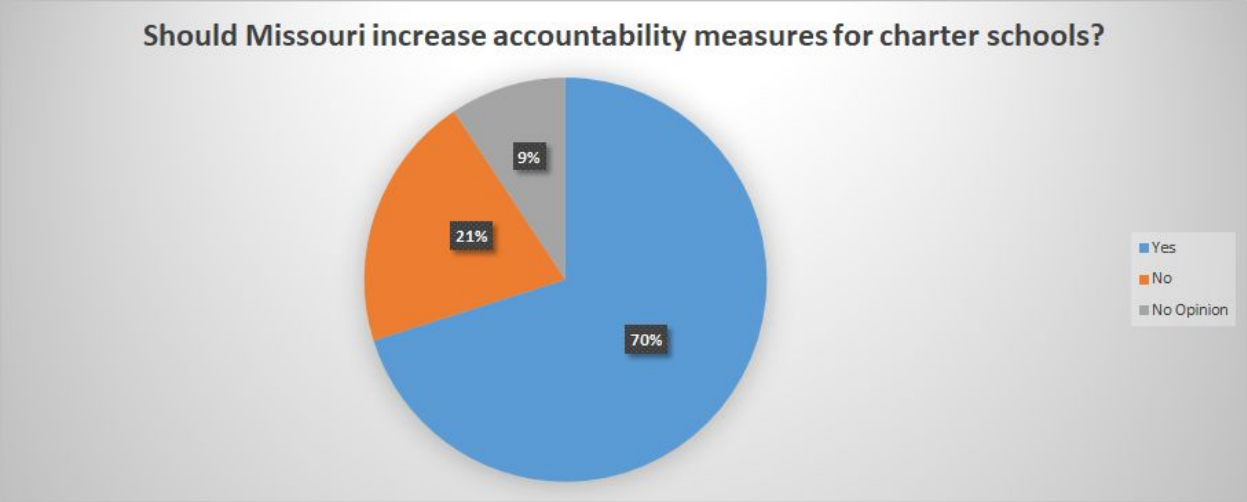
Should Missouri limit Local TIF districts to prevent the loss of property tax revenue for public services such as schools and libraries?



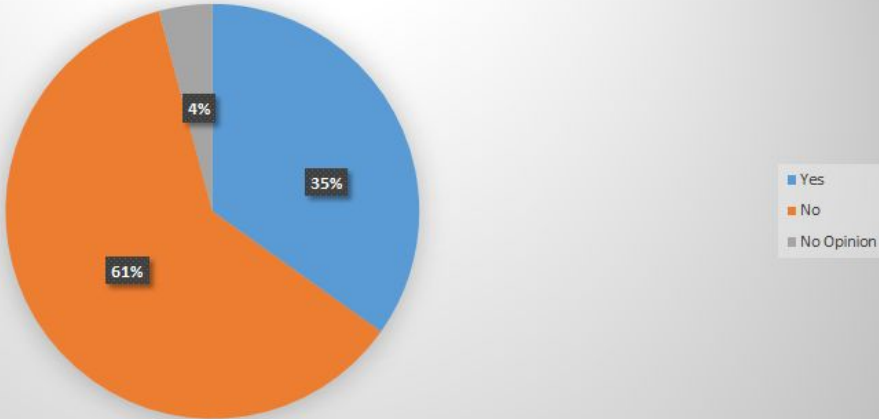
Should Missouri's tax laws be changed to apply the same sales tax rates and requirements to all purchases, including purchases made over the internet?



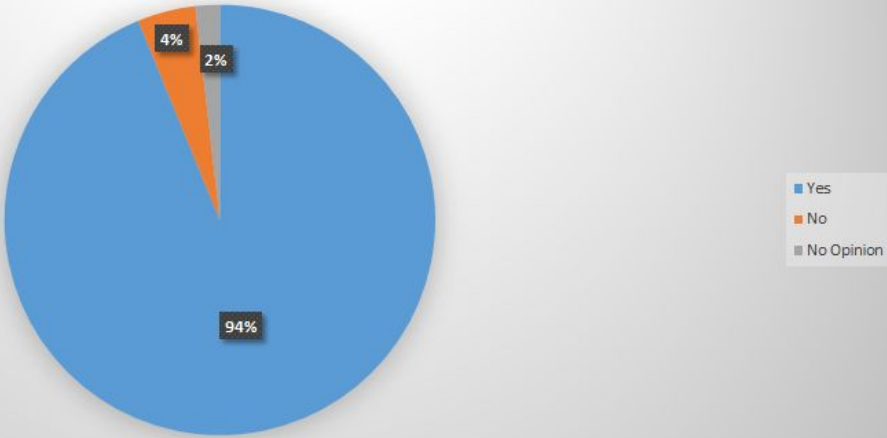
Education



Should Missouri set up a school voucher program, where a set amount of money follows a student to a public or private school at which they attend?

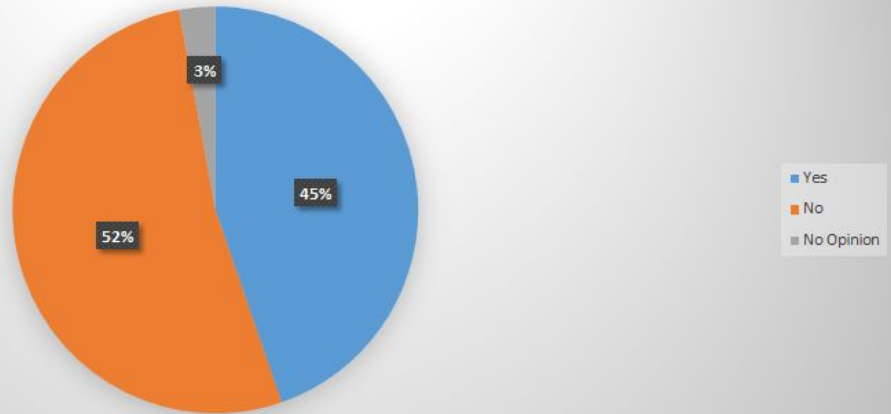


Should Missouri teachers be eligible to write off classroom expenses, paid out of their own pockets, on their state taxes?

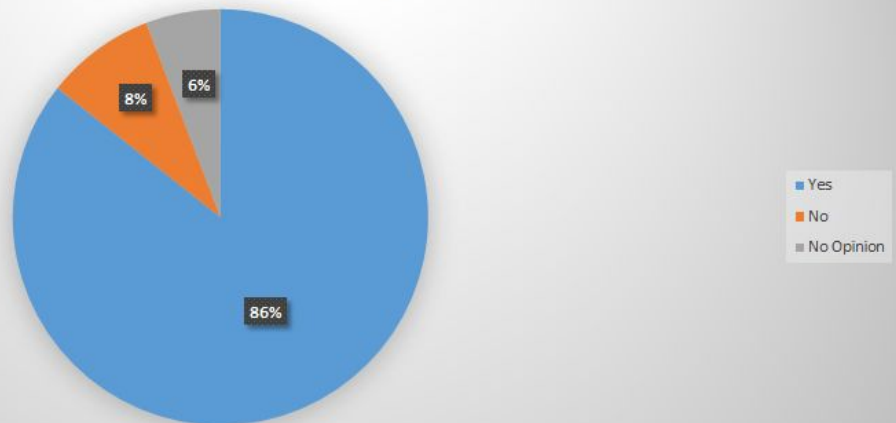


Health Care

Should the state of Missouri intervene and attempt to reduce the cost of prescription drugs?

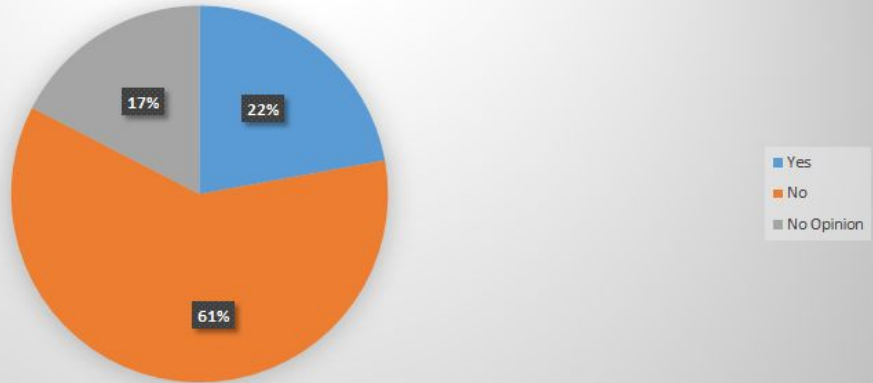


Should the Missouri Legislature restore funding to the Missouri Rx Prescription Drug Program?

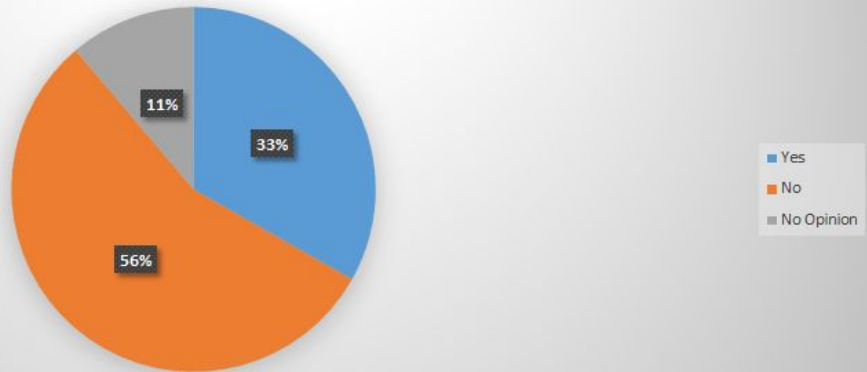


Tort Reform

Should Missouri do more to prevent multiple plaintiffs from joining together to bring a single, collective lawsuit?

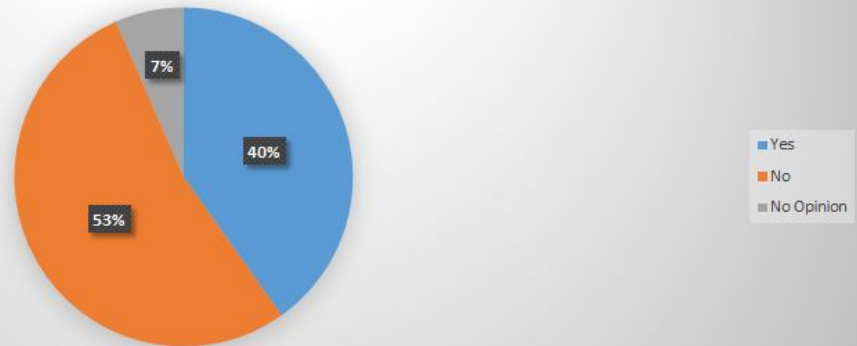


Should Missouri further limit the amount and/or type of damages that may be recovered by an injured person in a civil lawsuit?

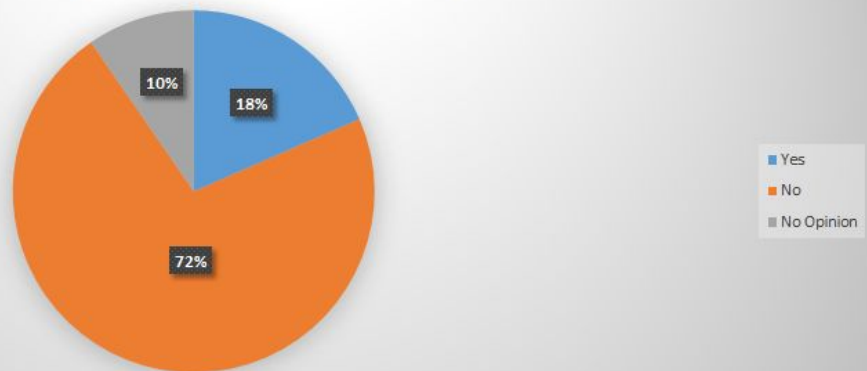


Transportation
