1 under the authority delegated in this section shall become 2 effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the 3 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the 4 powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 5 6 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and 7 annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the 8 grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted 9 after the effective date of this act shall be invalid and void."; 10 and

11 Further amend said bill, Page 39, Section 379.122, Line 5 of 12 said page, by inserting after all of said line the following:

13 "650.005. 1. There is hereby created a "Department of Public Safety" in charge of a director appointed by the governor 14 15 with the advice and consent of the senate. The department's role 16 will be to provide overall coordination in the state's public 17 safety and law enforcement program, to provide channels of 18 coordination with local and federal agencies in regard to public 19 safety, law enforcement and with all correctional and judicial 20 agencies in regard to matters pertaining to its responsibilities as they may interrelate with the other agencies or offices of 21 22 state, local or federal governments.

2. All the powers, duties and functions of the state 24 highway patrol, chapter 43 and others, are transferred by type II 25 transfer to the department of public safety. The governor by and 26 with the advice and consent of the senate shall appoint the 27 superintendent of the patrol. With the exception of sections 28 43.100 to 43.120 relating to financial procedures, the director 29 of public safety shall succeed the state highways and

1 transportation commission in approving actions of the superintendent and related matters as provided in chapter 43. 2 3 Uniformed members of the patrol shall be selected in the manner provided by law and shall receive the compensation provided by 4 law. Nothing in the Reorganization Act of 1974, however, shall 5 6 be interpreted to affect the funding of appropriations or the 7 operation of chapter 104 relating to retirement system coverage 8 or section 226.160 relating to workers' compensation for members 9 of the patrol.

10 3. All the powers, duties and functions of the supervisor 11 of liquor control, chapter 311 and others, are transferred by type II transfer to the department of public safety. The 12 13 supervisor shall be nominated by the department director and 14 appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the 15 senate. The supervisor shall appoint such agents, assistants, 16 deputies and inspectors as limited by appropriations. All 17 employees shall have the qualifications provided by law and may 18 be removed by the supervisor or director of the department as 19 provided in section 311.670.

4. All the powers, duties and functions of the safety and fire prevention bureau of the department of public health and welfare are transferred by type I transfer to the director of public safety.

5. All the powers, duties and functions of the state fire marshal, chapter 320 and others, are transferred to the department of public safety by a type I transfer.

All the powers, duties and functions of the law
enforcement assistance council administering federal grants,
planning and the like relating to Public Laws 90-351, 90-445 and

related acts of Congress are transferred by type I transfer to
 the director of public safety. The director of public safety
 shall appoint such advisory bodies as are required by federal
 laws or regulations. The council is abolished.

5 7. The director of public safety shall promulgate motor 6 vehicle regulations and be ex officio a member of the safety 7 compact commission in place of the director of revenue and all 8 powers, duties and functions relating to chapter 307 are 9 transferred by type I transfer to the director of public safety.

8. [The office of adjutant general and the state militia
are assigned to the department of public safety; provided,
however, nothing herein shall be construed to interfere with the
powers and duties of the governor as provided in Article IV,
Section 6 of the Constitution of the state of Missouri or chapter
41.

16 All the powers, duties and functions of the Missouri 9.] 17 boat commission, chapter 306 and others, are transferred by type 18 I transfer to the "Missouri State Water Patrol", which is hereby created, in the department of public safety. The Missouri boat 19 20 commission and the office of secretary to the commission are 21 abolished. All deputy boat commissioners and all other employees 22 of the commission who were employed on February 1, 1974, shall be 23 transferred to the water patrol without further qualification. 24 Effective January 1, 2011, all the powers, duties, and functions 25 of the Missouri state water patrol are transferred to the 26 division of water patrol within the Missouri state highway patrol 27 as set out in section 43.390.

[10.] <u>9.</u> The Missouri veterans's commission, chapter 42, is
assigned to the department of public safety.

1 [11.] 10. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is 2 defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority 3 delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 4 5 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and 6 chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay 7 8 the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are 9 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2009, 10 11 shall be invalid and void.

Section B. The enactment of section 41.035 and the repeal and reenactment of section 650.005 of this act shall become effective only upon approval by the voters of an amendment to article IV of the Constitution of Missouri that establishes the department of military forces."; and

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Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
