AN ACT

To amend chapter 407, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the sale of baby crib bumper pads, with penalty provisions and a delayed effective date.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 407, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 407.780, to read as follows:

407.780. 1. As used in this section, the following terms shall 2 mean:

(1) "Children's product", a product including, but not limited to,
a crib, toddler bed, bed, car seat, chair, high chair, booster chair, bath
seat, gate or other enclosure for confining a child, play yard, stationary
activity center, carrier, stroller, walker, swing, or toy or play
equipment that is designed or intended for the care of or use by a child;
(2) "Commercial dealer", any person who deals in children's
products or crib bumper pads or who otherwise by one's occupation

holds oneself out as having knowledge or skill relating to children's
products or crib bumper pads or any person who is in the business of
remanufacturing, retrofitting, selling, leasing, subletting, or otherwise
placing in the stream of commerce children's products or crib bumper
pads;

(3) "Crib bumper pad", a pad or pads of nonmesh material
including, but not limited to, a roll of stuffed fabric that is designed for
placement within a crib to cushion one or more of the crib's inner sides
adjacent to the crib mattress. Crib bumper pad shall not include mesh
liners;

20 (4) "Distributor" or "wholesaler", any person other than a 21 manufacturer or retailer who sells or resells or otherwise places into 22 the stream of commerce a children's product or crib bumper pad;

(5) "Importer", any person who brings into this country and
places into the stream of commerce a children's product or crib bumper
pad;

26 (6) "Manufacturer", any person who makes and places into the 27 stream of commerce a children's product or crib bumper pad;

(7) "Retailer", any person other than a manufacturer, distributor,
or wholesaler who sells, leases, or sublets children's products or crib
bumper pads.

2. No commercial dealer, distributor, wholesaler, importer, manufacturer, or retailer shall sell, lease, offer for sale, or offer for lease in the state any crib bumper pad as an accessory to a crib or as a separate item.

35 3. Any violation of the provisions of this section shall result in 36 a penalty of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five 37 hundred dollars for each offense.

Section B. The enactment of section 407.780 of this act shall become 2 effective on January 1, 2021.
