## AN ACT

To amend chapter 188, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to pelvic examinations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 188, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new

section, to be known as section 188.032, to read as follows:

188.032. No physician or other health care provider shall perform

- a pelvic examination of a patient prior to the performance or induction
- of an abortion, unless the treating physician determines that such
- 4 examination is medically necessary according to his or her reasonable
- 5 medical judgment. If the treating physician determines that a pelvic
- 6 examination is medically necessary, such physician shall ensure that
- 7 the examination is performed at the medically appropriate time
- according to his or her reasonable medical judgment.
