AN ACT

To amend chapter 170, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to instruction in cursive writing.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 170, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 170.025, to read as follows:

170.025. 1. Each school district shall ensure that:

2 (1) Its elementary school or schools provide instruction in 3 cursive writing so that students create readable documents through 4 legible cursive handwriting by the end of the fifth grade; and

5 (2) Students pass with proficiency a teacher-constructed test 6 demonstrating their competency in both reading and writing cursive.

7 2. The department of elementary and secondary education may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section. Any rule 8 or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is 9 created under the authority delegated in this section shall become 10 effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions 11 of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and 1213 chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the 14 effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held 15unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule 16 proposed or adopted after August 28, 2020, shall be invalid and void. 17
