## AN ACT

To amend chapter 196, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to opioid addiction treatment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 196, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new

section, to be known as section 196.1050, to read as follows: 196.1050. The proceeds of any monetary settlement or portion of
