## AN ACT

To amend chapters 160 and 173, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to suicide prevention for students.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapters 160 and 173, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto  
2 two new sections, to be known as sections 160.980 and 173.1202, to read as  
3 follows:

**160.980. 1. Beginning July 1, 2021, all public schools and charter  
2 schools, that serve students in grades seven to twelve, and that issue  
3 student identification cards shall have printed on either side of the  
4 student identification cards the telephone number for the National  
5 Suicide Prevention Lifeline.**

**6 2. A public school or charter school that issues student  
7 identification cards may have printed on either side of the student  
8 identification cards the telephone numbers of:**

**9 (1) The Crisis Text Line; or**

**10 (2) A local suicide prevention hotline telephone number.**

**11 3. Beginning January 1, 2021, if a school subject to the  
12 requirements of this section has a supply of unissued student  
13 identification cards that do not comply with the requirements of this  
14 section, the school shall issue such student identification cards until  
15 that supply is depleted.**

**16 4. The provisions of this section shall apply to a student  
17 identification card issued for the first time to a student, and to a  
18 student identification card issued to replace a damaged or lost student  
19 identification card.**

**173.1202. 1. Beginning July 1, 2021, a public institution of higher**

2 education that issues student identification cards shall have printed on  
3 either side of the student identification cards the telephone number for  
4 the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.

5 2. A public institution of higher education that issues student  
6 identification cards may have printed on either side of the student  
7 identification cards the telephone numbers of:

8 (1) The Crisis Text Line;

9 (2) The campus police or security telephone number, or if the  
10 campus does not have a campus police or security telephone number,  
11 the local law enforcement authority's telephone number; and

12 (3) A local suicide prevention hotline telephone number.

13 3. Beginning January 1, 2021, if a school subject to the  
14 requirements of this section has a supply of unissued student  
15 identification cards that do not comply with the requirements of this  
16 section, the public institution of higher education shall issue such  
17 student identification cards until that supply is depleted.

18 4. The provisions of this section shall apply to a student  
19 identification card issued for the first time to a student, and to a  
20 student identification card issued to replace a damaged or lost student  
21 identification card.
