## AN ACT

To repeal section 506.384, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to civil actions brought by inmates in county jails.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 506.384, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 506.384, to read as follows:

506.384. 1. No civil action may be brought by an offender, or an inmate 2 or detainee in a county jail, except for a constitutional deprivation, until all 3 administrative remedies are exhausted.

2. If a claim is, on its face, frivolous, malicious, fails to state a claim upon
which relief may be granted or seeks monetary relief from a defendant who is
immune from such relief, the court may dismiss the underlying claim without
first requiring the exhaustion of administrative remedies.

8 3. A civil action pursued by an offender in a court of this state alleging in 9 whole or in part a violation of federal law shall be subject to all limitations on 10 remedies established by federal law.
