AN ACT

To amend chapter 208, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to hospital federal reimbursement allowances.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 208, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 208.485, to read as follows:

208.485. 1. No person, association, corporation, partnership, institution, agency, or other entity shall charge or accept a fee, gift, donation, or other moneys relating to the expenses of administering an arrangement in which hospital MO HealthNet providers, or entities related to hospital providers, participate voluntarily to make redistribution payments from funds, which may or may not include MO HealthNet funds, to other hospital MO HealthNet providers, or entities related to hospital providers, with the reasonable expectation that participating hospital MO HealthNet providers shall receive a return of all or any portion of the hospital's federal reimbursement allowance amount assessed under sections 208.453 to 208.480.

2. Any hospital, as such term is defined in section 197.020, that remits any fee, gift, donation, or other moneys to any person, association, corporation, partnership, institution, agency, or other entity administering an arrangement as described in subsection 1 of this section with the reasonable expectation, as determined in the totality of the circumstances, of compensating such person, association, corporation, partnership, institution, agency, or other entity for the administration of such arrangement shall be subject to denial, suspension, or revocation of the hospital's license under the provisions of chapter 197.
