AN ACT

To repeal section 8.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to meetings of the board of public buildings.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 8.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 8.010, to read as follows:

8.010. 1. The governor, attorney general and lieutenant governor
2 constitute the board of public buildings. The governor is chairman and the
3 lieutenant governor, secretary. The speaker of the house of representatives and
4 the president pro tempore of the senate shall serve as ex officio members of the
5 board but shall not have the power to vote. The board shall constitute a body
6 corporate and politic. Except as provided under section 8.007, the board has
7 general supervision and charge of the public property of the state at the seat of
8 government, including the building located at 105 West Capitol Avenue in
9 Jefferson City, and other duties imposed on it by law.

10 2. The commissioner of administration shall provide staff support to the
11 board. **The board may meet in the seat of government and any other**
12 **location throughout the state, and any member of the board may**
13 **participate in a meeting of the board in person, via videoconferencing**
14 **or any other electronic means, provided that any meeting shall comply**
15 **with the provisions of section 610.020.**
