2	by inserting after all of said line the following:
3	"311.367. 1. The provisions of this section shall
4	apply to all persons, firms, or corporations who own and
5	operate more than one premises licensed to sell intoxicating
6	liquor containing alcohol in excess of five percent by
7	weight at retail.
8	2. Any person, firm, or corporation described in
9	subsection 1 of this section, with the permission of the
10	supervisor of alcohol and tobacco control, may designate one
11	or more places in this state as a central warehouse to which
12	intoxicating liquors ordered and purchased by a person,
13	firm, or corporation from licensed wholesalers in this
14	state, upon mutual agreement between such wholesaler and
15	person, firm, or corporation, may be delivered by licensed
16	wholesalers in this state and at which intoxicating liquors
17	so owned by a person, firm, or corporation may be stored.
18	3. Any person, firm, or corporation described in
19	subsection 1 of this section who owns and stores
20	intoxicating liquors in a central warehouse may transport or
21	transfer all or any part of the intoxicating liquors so
22	stored from the central warehouse in this state to any
23	premises licensed to sell intoxicating liquors at retail
24	which is owned and operated by the same person, firm, or
25	corporation and which is located in the state; provided,
26	however, beer and other intoxicating malt liquor are not

- 27 transferred from the central warehouses to other retail
- 28 licensed premises due to the perishability and limited life
- 29 span of beer and intoxicating malt liquor, and due to the
- 30 specific designated geographic areas for the beer and other
- 31 intoxicating malt liquor wholesalers, which have been
- 32 authorized by the brewers and approved by the supervisor of
- 33 alcohol and tobacco control."
