Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 98, Page 57, Section 313.1000, Line 148,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "(27) "Sports wagering supplier", a person that  
4 provides sports wagering services, sports wagering kiosks,  
5 sports wagering software, or other components necessary for  
6 a sports wagering operation and the creation of wagering  
7 markets, directly or indirectly to any certificate holder or  
8 licensed applicant, including, but not limited to providers  
9 of data feeds and odds services, internet platform  
10 providers, risk management providers, integrity monitoring  
11 providers, and other providers of sports wagering supplier  
12 services as determined by the commission. A sports  
13 governing body that provides raw statistical match data to  
14 one or more designated and licensed providers of data and  
15 odds services shall not be a sports wagering supplier;

16 (28) "Sports wagering supplier license", a license  
17 issued by the commission to a sports wagering supplier;"  
18 and further amend by renumbering the remaining subdivisions  
19 accordingly; and

20 Further amend said bill, page 61, Section 313.1006,  
21 line 15, by inserting after all of said line the following:

22 "313.1007. 1. The commission may issue a sports  
23 wagering supplier license to a sports wagering supplier. A  
24 person that is not licensed under this section shall not  
25 sell, lease, distribute, offer, or otherwise provide sports  
26 wagering services, sports wagering kiosks, sports wagering

27 software, or other components necessary for a sports  
28 wagering operation, directly or indirectly to any  
29 certificate holder or licensed applicant. A supplier shall  
30 be licensed under this section if providing supplier  
31 services under a fixed-fee or revenue-sharing agreement.

32 2. On application by an interested person, the  
33 commission may issue a provisional sports wagering supplier  
34 license to an applicant for a sports wagering supplier  
35 license. A provisional license issued under this subsection  
36 shall allow the applicant for the sports wagering supplier  
37 license to conduct business regarding the operation of  
38 sports wagering with a certificate holder or licensed  
39 applicant before the sports wagering supplier license is  
40 issued. A provisional license issued under this subsection  
41 shall expire on the date provided by the commission.

42 3. A person may apply to the commission for a sports  
43 wagering supplier license as provided in this section and  
44 the rules promulgated under this section.

45 4. Except as otherwise provided in this section, an  
46 application under this section shall be made on forms  
47 provided by the commission and shall include the information  
48 required by the commission.

49 5. The commission shall require applicants to disclose  
50 the identity of:

51 (1) The applicant's principal owners who directly own  
52 five percent or more of the applicant;

53 (2) Each holding, intermediary, or parent company that  
54 directly owns fifteen percent or more of the applicant; and

55 (3) The applicant's board appointed chief executive  
56 officer and chief financial officer.

57 The commission shall have the authority to waive any or all  
58 qualification requirements for any person or entity in this  
59 subsection.

60           6. State entities and public corporations that are  
61 direct or indirect shareholders of the applicant shall be  
62 waived from any information disclosure requests in  
63 connection to the license application as determined by the  
64 commission.

65           7. Investment funds or entities registered with the  
66 federal Securities and Exchange Commission, whether as  
67 investment advisors or otherwise, as well as the entities  
68 under the management of such entities registered with the  
69 federal Securities and Exchange Commission, that are direct  
70 or indirect shareholders of the applicant, shall be waived  
71 from any information disclosure requests in connection to  
72 the license application as determined by the commission.

73           8. In no scenario shall a person holding a sports  
74 wagering supplier license or a provisional sports wagering  
75 supplier license be subject to, or required to obtain, any  
76 additional license to offer the services under this section.

77           9. The commission shall promulgate rules to implement  
78 the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a  
79 rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is  
80 created under the authority delegated in this section shall  
81 become effective only if it complies with and is subject to  
82 all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable,  
83 section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are  
84 nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the  
85 general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay  
86 the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are  
87 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of  
88 rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after  
89 August 28, 2021, shall be invalid and void."; and

90           Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
