Unclaimed Property Listing:

A little background about why we do this: one in 10 Missourians has Unclaimed Property waiting for them. As State Treasurer it is my responsibility to return as much of Missouri's \$1 billion of Unclaimed Property as possible. With more than 5 million accounts across the state, some of those funds belong to individuals, businesses, or local governments in District 9.

You can search for and claim your property free of charge on www.ShowMeMoney.com.

A review of the Unclaimed Property database indicates I am currently holding \$33,122,317.57 belonging to approximately 278,107 account owners in District 9.

Banks, businesses, and insurance companies turn over Unclaimed Property to me after accounts have been inactive and owners cannot be successfully contacted for a statutorily defined period of time, generally five years.

I hold Unclaimed Property in perpetuity until the owner or a proper heir is located and claims it. Account owners can file a claim online or request a paper claim be mailed to them at any time by visiting www.ShowMeMoney.com. By law, specific dollar amounts that exceed \$50 are not public record.

My office will publish names of Unclaimed Property owners in newspapers around the state in June. Constituents may also see information regarding Unclaimed Property on the Treasurer's Office <u>Facebook</u> and <u>Twitter</u> pages.

To file a claim or check for Unclaimed Property, individuals may visit www.ShowMeMoney.com or write to the Treasurer's office at PO Box 1004, Jefferson City, MO 65102-1004.
