AN ACT

To repeal sections 196.931 and 196.935, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the selling of raw milk or cream.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Sections 196.931 and 196.935, RSMo, are
- 2 repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be
- 3 known as sections 196.931 and 196.935, to read as follows:
 - 196.931. As used in sections 196.931 to 196.953 unless
- 2 the context clearly indicates otherwise, the following words
- 3 and terms shall have the meaning indicated:
- 4 (1) "Grade A pasteurized milk", grade A raw milk for
- 5 pasteurization which has been pasteurized, cooled, and
- 6 placed in the final container in a milk plant and conforming
- 7 with the sanitation and bacteriological standards authorized
- 8 by sections 196.931 to 196.953 and regulations promulgated
- 9 thereunder;
- 10 (2) "Grade A raw milk for pasteurization", raw milk
- 11 for pasteurization from producer dairies and conforming with
- 12 all of the sanitation and bacteriological standards
- authorized by sections 196.931 to 196.953 and regulations
- 14 which are promulgated thereunder;
- 15 (3) "Grade A retail raw milk or cream", raw milk or
- 16 cream produced upon dairy farms conforming to a sanitation
- 17 standard that specifies that the bacterial plate count of
- 18 the milk or cream shall not exceed fifty thousand per

- 20 "Graded fluid milk and fluid milk products", milk 21 (4) products include cream, light cream, coffee cream, table 22 cream, whipping cream, light whipping cream, heavy cream, 23 24 heavy whipping cream, whipped cream, whipped light cream, whipped coffee cream, whipped table cream, sour cream, 25 26 cultured sour cream, half-and-half, sour half-and-half, cultured half-and-half, reconstituted or recombined milk and 27 28 milk products, concentrated milk, concentrated milk products, skim milk, skimmed milk, lowfat milk, fortified 29 milk and milk products, vitamin D milk and milk products, 30

- 44 are collected, handled, processed, stored, bottled,
- 45 pasteurized and prepared for distribution, except an

196.935. No person shall sell, offer for sale, expose

- 2 for sale, transport, or deliver any graded fluid milk or
- 3 graded fluid milk products in this state unless the milk or
- 4 milk products are graded and produced, transported,
- 5 processed, manufactured, distributed, labeled and sold under
- 6 state milk inspection and the same has also been produced or
- 7 pasteurized as required by a regulation authorized by
- 8 section 196.939 and under proper permits issued thereunder.
- 9 Only pasteurized graded fluid milk and fluid milk products
- as defined in subdivision [(3)] (4) of section 196.931 shall
- 11 be sold to the final consumer, or to restaurants, soda
- 12 fountains, grocery stores, or similar establishments; except
- 13 that:
- 14 (1) Grade A retail raw milk or cream produced in
- 15 Missouri may be sold to grocery stores, restaurants, soda
- 16 fountains, or similar establishments as long as:
- 17 (a) The grade A retail raw milk or cream is clearly
- 18 labeled "WARNING: This product has not been pasteurized
- 19 and, therefore, may contain harmful bacteria that can cause
- 20 serious illness in children, the elderly, and persons with
- 21 weakened immune systems."; and
- 22 (b) If the grade A retail raw milk or cream is sold in
- 23 a manner that does not allow the final consumer to see the
- 24 product with the label described in paragraph (a) of this
- 25 subdivision, the label is presented to the consumer through
- 26 a written notice on the menu or in some other manner; and
- 27 (2) An individual, who is the final consumer, may
- 28 purchase and have delivered to him or her for his or her own
- 29 use raw milk or cream from a farm.
