### AN ACT

To repeal section 104.160, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the board of trustees of the Missouri department of transportation and highway patrol employees' retirement system.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 104.160, RSMo, is repealed and one new  
2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 104.160,  
3 to read as follows:

104.160. The board of trustees shall consist of [three  
2 members] **one member** of the state highways and transportation  
3 commission elected by the members of the commission. The  
4 superintendent of the highway patrol and the director of the  
5 department of transportation shall serve as members by  
6 virtue of their respective offices, and their successors  
7 shall succeed them as members of the board of trustees. In  
8 addition, one member of the senate appointed by the  
9 president pro tem of the senate and one member of the house  
10 of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house,  
11 **and one person with institutional investment experience**  
12 **appointed by the governor** shall serve as members of the  
13 board of trustees. In addition to the [appointed  
14 legislators] **appointees**, two active employee members of the  
15 system shall be elected by a plurality vote of the active  
16 employee members of the system, herein designated for four-  
17 year terms to commence July 1, 1982, and every four years

**EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.**

18 thereafter. One elected member shall be elected from the  
19 active employees of the department of transportation and one  
20 elected member shall be elected from the active employees of  
21 the civilian or uniformed highway patrol. In addition to  
22 the two active employee members, two retirees of the system  
23 shall be elected to serve on the board by a plurality vote  
24 of the retirees of the system. One retiree shall be elected  
25 by the retired employees of the transportation department  
26 and one retiree shall be elected by the retired employees of  
27 the civilian or uniformed highway patrol. The retiree  
28 serving on the board on August 28, 2007, shall continue to  
29 serve on the board as the representative of the retired  
30 employees of the transportation department until June 30,  
31 2010. An election shall be held prior to January 1, 2008,  
32 for the retiree to be elected by the retired employees of  
33 the civilian or uniformed highway patrol with said term to  
34 commence on January 1, 2008, and expire on June 30, 2010.  
35 All terms of elected retired employees shall be for four  
36 years after June 30, 2010. The board shall determine the  
37 procedures for nomination and election of the elective board  
38 members. Nominations may be entered by any member of the  
39 system, provided members of the system have a reasonable  
40 opportunity to vote.
