AN ACT

To repeal section 303.220, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to certificates of self-insurance, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 303.220, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 303.220,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 303.220. 1. Any religious denomination which has more
- 2 than twenty-five members with motor vehicles and [prohibits]
- 3 discourages its members from purchasing insurance, of any
- 4 form, as being contrary to its religious tenets, may qualify
- 5 as a self-insurer by obtaining a self-insurance certificate
- 6 issued by the director as provided in subsection 3 of this
- 7 section.
- 8 2. Any person in whose name more than twenty-five
- 9 motor vehicles are registered may qualify as a self-insurer
- 10 by obtaining a certificate of self-insurance issued by the
- 11 director as provided in subsection 3 of this section.
- 12 3. The director may, in his discretion, upon the
- 13 application of any religious denomination or person
- 14 described in subsection 1 or 2 of this section, issue a
- 15 certificate of self-insurance when he is satisfied that such
- 16 religious denomination or person is possessed and will
- 17 continue to be possessed of the ability to pay judgments
- 18 obtained against such religious denomination or person.

4. Upon not less than ten days' notice and a hearing 19 20 pursuant to such notice, the director may, upon reasonable grounds, cancel a certificate of self-insurance. Failure to 21 22 pay any judgment within thirty days after such judgment shall have become final shall constitute a reasonable ground 23 24 for the cancellation of a certificate of self-insurance. Section B. Because of the need to provide options for 2 people to comply with The Motor Vehicle Financial 3 Responsibility Law without violating their religious conscience, section A of this act is deemed necessary for 4 5 the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency 6 act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of 7 8 this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage
