## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 442, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to actions to quiet title involving subsurface rights.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 442, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 442.690, to read as
- 3 follows:
  - 442.690. 1. As used in this section, the following
- 2 terms shall mean:
- 3 (1) "Exercise of subsurface rights", includes, but is
- 4 not limited to, the following:
- 5 (a) The production of any coal or other minerals and
- 6 the production of any oil and gas under subsurface rights;
- 7 (b) Operations being conducted under subsurface rights
- 8 for injection, withdrawal, storage, or disposal of water,
- 9 oil, gas, or other fluid substances;
- (c) Payment of taxes or fees on subsurface rights by
- 11 the owner or owner's agent;
- 12 (d) A valid permit of any government agency pertaining
- 13 to the use of subsurface rights has been issued;
- 14 (2) "Subsurface rights", coal or other minerals, oil
- 15 or gas interests or rights, or any combination of those
- 16 rights or interests.
- 17 2. In an action to quiet title involving subsurface
- 18 rights to real property, failure by any person claiming to

hold the subsurface rights, other than the surface owner of the real property, to exercise the subsurface rights for a period in excess of twenty years shall create a rebuttable presumption that the subsurface rights have been abandoned by such person in favor of the surface owner.
