AN ACT

To repeal section 215.020, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the Missouri housing development commission.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 215.020, RSMo, is repealed and one new
2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 215.020,
3 to read as follows:

215.020. 1. There is hereby created and established
2 as a governmental instrumentality of the state of Missouri
3 the "Missouri Housing Development Commission" which shall
4 constitute a body corporate and politic.

5 2. The commission shall consist of the governor,
6 lieutenant governor, the state treasurer, the state attorney
7 general, **two members of the senate, one from each political**
8 **party, appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate,**
9 **two members of the house of representatives, one from each**
10 **political party, appointed by the speaker of the house of**
11 **representatives,** and six members to be selected by the
12 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate. The
13 persons to be selected by the governor shall be individuals
14 knowledgeable in the areas of housing, finance or
15 construction. Not more than four of the members appointed
16 by the governor shall be from the same political party. The
17 members of the commission appointed by the governor shall
18 serve the following terms: Two shall serve two years, two

19 shall serve three years, and two shall serve four years,
20 respectively. Thereafter, each appointment shall be for a
21 term of four years. If for any reason a vacancy occurs, the
22 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, shall
23 appoint a new member to fill the unexpired term. Members are
24 eligible for reappointment.

25 3. ~~[Six]~~ **Eight** members of the commission shall
26 constitute a quorum. No vacancy in the membership of the
27 commission shall impair the right of a quorum to exercise
28 all the rights and perform all the duties of the
29 commission. No action shall be taken by the commission
30 except upon the affirmative vote of at least ~~[six]~~ **eight** of
31 the members of the commission.

32 4. Each member of the commission appointed by the
33 governor is entitled to compensation of fifty dollars per
34 diem plus his reasonable and necessary expenses actually
35 incurred in discharging his duties under sections 215.010 to
36 215.250.

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
