AN ACT

To repeal section 57.317, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to compensation of sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 57.317, RSMo, is repealed and two new

- 2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 57.317
- 3 and 57.318, to read as follows:
 - 57.317. 1. The county sheriff in any first and second
- 2 classification county, other than in a first classification
- 3 chartered county, shall receive an annual salary computed as
- 4 set forth in the following schedule. The assessed valuation
- 5 factor shall be the amount thereof as shown for the year
- 6 next preceding the computation. The provisions of this
- 7 section shall not permit or require a reduction in the
- 8 amount of compensation being paid for the office of sheriff
- 9 on January 1, 1997.
