AN ACT

To repeal section 57.317, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to compensation of sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 57.317, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 57.317 and 57.318, to read as follows:

57.317. 1. The county sheriff in any **first and second classification** county, other than in a first classification chartered county, shall receive an annual salary computed as set forth in the following schedule. The assessed valuation factor shall be the amount thereof as shown for the year next preceding the computation. The provisions of this section shall not permit or require a reduction in the amount of compensation being paid for the office of sheriff on January 1, 1997.

65 2. Two thousand dollars of the salary authorized in
66 this section shall be payable to the sheriff only if the
67 sheriff has completed at least twenty hours of classroom
68 instruction each calendar year relating to the operations of
69 the sheriff's office when approved by a professional
70 association of the county sheriffs of Missouri unless
71 exempted from the training by the professional association.
72 The professional association approving the program shall
73 provide a certificate of completion to each sheriff who
74 completes the training program and shall send a list of
75 certified sheriffs to the treasurer of each county.
76 Expenses incurred for attending the training session may be
77 reimbursed to the county sheriff in the same manner as other
78 expenses as may be appropriated for that purpose.

79 3. The county sheriff in any **first and second**
80 **classification** county, other than a first classification
81 charter county, shall not, [except upon two-thirds vote of

82 all the members of the salary commission,] receive an annual
 83 compensation less than the total compensation being received
 84 for the office of county sheriff in the particular county
 85 for services rendered or performed on the date the salary
 86 commission votes.

57.318. 1. The county sheriff in any third and fourth
 2 classification county shall receive an annual salary
 3 computed as set forth in the following schedule. The
 4 assessed valuation factor shall be the amount thereof as
 5 shown for the year next preceding the computation. The
 6 provisions of this section shall not permit or require a
 7 reduction in amount of compensation being paid for the
 8 office of sheriff on January 1, 1997.
