AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to retail storage and transport of alcohol.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
2 one new section, to be known as section 311.367, to read as
3 follows:

311.367. 1. The provisions of this section shall
2 apply to all persons, firms, or corporations who own and
3 operate more than one premises licensed to sell intoxicating
4 liquor containing alcohol in excess of five percent by
5 weight at retail.

6 2. Any person, firm, or corporation described in
7 subsection 1 of this section, with the permission of the
8 supervisor of alcohol and tobacco control, may designate one
9 or more places in this state as a central warehouse to which
10 intoxicating liquors ordered and purchased by a person,
11 firm, or corporation from licensed wholesalers in this state
12 may be delivered by licensed wholesalers in this state and
13 at which intoxicating liquors so owned by a person, firm, or
14 corporation may be stored.

15 3. Any person, firm, or corporation described in
16 subsection 1 of this section who owns and stores
17 intoxicating liquors in a central warehouse may transport or
18 transfer all or any part of the intoxicating liquors so

19 stored from the central warehouse in this state to any
20 premises licensed to sell intoxicating liquors at retail
21 which is owned and operated by the same person, firm, or
22 corporation and which is located in the state; provided,
23 however, beer and other intoxicating malt liquor are not
24 transferred from the central warehouses to other retail
25 licensed premises due to the perishability and limited life
26 span of beer and intoxicating malt liquor, and due to the
27 specific designated geographic areas for the beer and other
28 intoxicating malt liquor wholesalers, which have been
29 authorized by the brewers and approved by the supervisor of
30 alcohol and tobacco control.
