## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 144.027, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to sales tax credit for the replacement of certain vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 144.027, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 144.027,
- 3 to read as follows:
  - 144.027. 1. When a motor vehicle, trailer, boat or
- 2 outboard motor for which all sales or use tax has been paid
- 3 is replaced due to theft or a casualty loss in excess of the
- 4 value of the unit, the director shall permit the amount of
- 5 the insurance proceeds plus any owner's deductible
- 6 obligation, as certified by the insurance company, to be a
- 7 credit against the purchase price of another motor vehicle,
- 8 trailer, boat or outboard motor which is purchased or is
- 9 contracted to purchase within [one hundred eighty days] two
- 10 years of the date of payment by the insurance company as a
- 11 replacement motor vehicle, trailer, boat or outboard motor.
- 12 As used in this section, the term "boat" includes all
- 13 motorboats and vessels, as the terms "motorboat" and
- "vessel" are defined in section 306.010.
- 15 2. If the owner of a motor vehicle, trailer, boat or
- 16 outboard motor as described in subsection 1 of this section
- 17 does not have insurance coverage for the motor vehicle,
- 18 trailer, boat or outboard motor, the director shall permit

the fair market value of the motor vehicle, trailer, boat or 19 outboard motor as determined by the Kelly Blue Book, NADA 20 21 Used Car Guide, Abos Blue Book or the average of two appraisals from licensed motor vehicle or boat dealers to be 22 a credit against the purchase price of a replacement motor 23 24 vehicle, trailer, boat or outboard motor which is purchased 25 or is contracted to purchase within [one hundred eighty days] two years of the date of such loss as certified by a 26 27 law enforcement agency or such other evidence as the director may require as proof of the date of loss of the 28 motor vehicle, trailer, boat or outboard motor. 29
