## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article I of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to the right to hunt and fish.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the

- 2 state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday
- 3 in November, 2022, or at a special election to be called by
- 4 the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to
- 5 the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or
- 6 rejection, the following amendment to article I of the
- 7 Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article I, Constitution of Missouri, is amended

- 2 by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 36,
- 3 to read as follows:

## Section 36. That hunting and fishing provides

- 2 exercise, social and emotional health, employment
- 3 opportunities, and nutritious proteins; and that hunters and
- 4 anglers are driving forces supporting Missouri's economy.
- 5 To protect this important heritage and fundamental right,
- 6 the right of hunters and anglers to engage in hunting,
- 7 fishing, and harvesting wildlife by traditional means shall
- 8 be forever guaranteed in this state, subject to duly
- 9 authorized powers conferred in article IV of the
- 10 Constitution of Missouri. Nothing in this section shall be
- 11 construed to prevent the general assembly from enacting

12 general laws that limit the rights of convicted violent

13 felons or those adjudicated by a court to be a danger to

one's self or others as a result of a mental disorder or

15 mental infirmity.
