JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment repealing section 2 of article I of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section in lieu thereof relating to the definition of person.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the

- 2 state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday
- 3 in November, 2022, or at a special election to be called by
- 4 the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to
- 5 the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or
- 6 rejection, the following amendment to article I of the
- 7 Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Section 2, article I, Constitution of Missouri,

- 2 is repealed and one new section adopted in lieu thereof, to be
- 3 known as section 2, to read as follows:

Section 2. That all constitutional government is

- 2 intended to promote the general welfare of the people; that
- 3 all persons have a natural right to life, liberty, the
- 4 pursuit of happiness and the enjoyment of the gains of their
- 5 own industry; that all persons are created equal and are
- 6 entitled to equal rights and opportunity under the law; that
- 7 under this Constitution and the laws of this state, unless
- 8 defined otherwise, the term "person" shall mean only human
- 9 persons and legislatively-created or recognized judicial
- 10 entities; that to give security to these things is the

11 principal office of government, and that when government

12 does not confer this security, it fails in its chief design.
