Amend Senate Bill No. 984, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 2,

2 by striking "flood resiliency" and inserting in lieu thereof  
3 the following: "environmental protection"; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 4, section 256.800, line  
5 90, by inserting after all of said line the following:

6 "260.221. 1. As used in this section, the following  
7 terms mean:

8 (1) "Processed recycled asphalt shingles", recycled  
9 asphalt shingles that do not contain extraneous metals,  
10 glass, rubber, nails, soil, brick, tars, paper, wood, and  
11 plastics and that have been reduced in size to produce a  
12 commercially reasonable usable product. "Processed recycled  
13 asphalt shingles" shall also be considered clean fill, as  
14 such term is defined in section 260.200;

15 (2) "Recycled asphalt shingles", manufacture waste  
16 scrap shingles and post-consumer, tear-off scrap shingles  
17 that are accumulated as products for commercial purposes  
18 related to recycling or reuse as processed recycled asphalt  
19 shingles.

20 2. Processed recycled asphalt shingles may be used for  
21 fill, reclamation, and other beneficial purposes without a  
22 permit under sections 260.200 to 260.345 if such processed  
23 recycled asphalt shingles are inspected for toxic and  
24 hazardous substances in accordance with requirements  
25 established by the department of natural resources, provided  
26 that processed recycled asphalt shingles shall not be used

27 for such purposes within five hundred feet of any lake,  
28 river, sink hole, perennial stream, or ephemeral stream, and  
29 shall not be used for such purposes below surface level and  
30 closer than fifty feet above the water table.

31 3. This section shall not be construed to authorize  
32 the abandonment, accumulation, placement, or storage of  
33 recycled asphalt shingles or processed recycled asphalt  
34 shingles on any real property without the consent of the  
35 real property owner.

36 644.060. 1. Processed recycled asphalt shingles, as  
37 defined in section 260.221, may be used for fill,  
38 reclamation, and other beneficial purposes without a permit  
39 under sections 644.006 to 644.141 if such processed recycled  
40 asphalt shingles are inspected for toxic and hazardous  
41 substances in accordance with requirements established by  
42 the department of natural resources, provided that processed  
43 recycled asphalt shingles shall not be used for such  
44 purposes within five hundred feet of any lake, river, sink  
45 hole, perennial stream, or ephemeral stream, and shall not  
46 be used for such purposes below surface level and closer  
47 than fifty feet above the water table.

48 2. This section shall not be construed to authorize  
49 the abandonment, accumulation, placement, or storage of  
50 recycled asphalt shingles or processed recycled asphalt  
51 shingles on any real property without the consent of the  
52 real property owner."; and
