Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 741, Page 1, Section TITLE, Lines 3-4,

2 by striking "the disclosure of personal information to
3 public agencies" and inserting in lieu thereof the
4 following: "involvement of public agencies in the
5 disclosure of information"; and

6 Further amend said bill, page 4, section 105.1500, line
7 90, by inserting after all of said line the following:

8 "161.841. 1. This section shall be known and may be
9 cited as the "Parents' Access to Public School Records Act".

10 2. As used in this section, the term "parent" means a
11 child's parent, guardian, or other person having control or
12 custody of the child.

13 3. This section shall be construed to empower parents
14 to enforce the following rights to access public records
15 maintained by school districts and public schools in which
16 their children are enrolled that receive any federal or
17 state moneys:

18 (1) The right to know what their minor child is being
19 taught in school including, but not limited to, curricula,
20 books, and other instructional materials;

21 (2) The right to receive information about who is
22 teaching their minor child including, but not limited to,
23 guest lecturers and outside presenters;

24 (3) The right to receive information about individuals
25 and organizations receiving school contracts and funding;

26 (4) The right to view or receive all school records,
27 medical or otherwise, concerning their minor child;

28 (5) The right to receive information about the
29 collection and transmission of their minor child's data;

30 (6) The right to have sufficient accountability and
31 transparency regarding school board records; and

32 (7) The right to know about records regarding
33 situations affecting their minor child's safety in school.

34 4. No school district or public school shall require
35 nondisclosure agreements or similar forms for a parent's
36 review of curricula. Each public school or school district
37 shall allow parents to make copies of curriculum documents.

38 5. No school district or public school shall collect
39 any biometric data or other sensitive personal information
40 about a minor child without obtaining written parental
41 consent before collecting such data or information.

42 6. Each school board meeting pertaining to curricula,
43 safety, or other student issues shall be held in public and
44 allow for public comments.

45 7. Each school district and public school shall notify
46 parents in a timely manner of all reported incidents
47 pertaining to student safety including, but not limited to,
48 any felony or misdemeanor committed by teachers or other
49 school employees."; and

50 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
