 6 37, by inserting after "393.110," the following: "for the
 7 purposes of constructing electric plant subject to a
 8 certificate of convenience and necessity under subsection 1
 9 of section 393.170"; and further amend line 39 by inserting
 10 after "court." the following: "The provisions of this
 11 subsection shall not apply to applications filed pursuant to
 12 section 393.170 prior to August 28, 2022."; and

13 Further amend said bill, page 8, section 523.040, line
 14 64 by inserting after "property," the following: "for
 15 purposes of constructing electric plant subject to a
 16 certificate of convenience and necessity under subsection 1
 17 of section 393.170"; and further amend line 68 by inserting
 18 after "situated." the following: "The provisions of this
 19 subsection shall not apply to applications filed pursuant to
 20 section 393.170 prior to August 28, 2022."; and

21 Further amend said bill, page 9, section 523.256, lines
 22 19-28, by striking all of said lines and inserting in lieu
 23 thereof the following: "hundred forty-five kilovolts or
 24 greater, but not for condemnation of such property by an
 25 electrical corporation operating under a cooperative
 26 business plan as described in section 393.110, for the

27 purposes of constructing electric plant subject to a
28 certificate of convenience and necessity under subsection 1
29 of section 393.170, the total compensation package offered
30 was no lower than the amount reflected in an appraisal
31 performed by a state-licensed or state-certified appraiser
32 for the condemning authority multiplied by one hundred fifty
33 percent. The provisions of this subdivision shall not apply
34 to applications filed pursuant to section 393.170 prior to
35 August 28, 2022;".
