Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 1606, Page 11, Section 58.200, Line 17,

by inserting after all of said line the following: 2 3 "70.631. 1. Each political subdivision may, by majority vote of its governing body, elect to cover 4 emergency telecommunicators, jailors, and emergency medical 5 service personnel as public safety personnel members of the 6 7 system. The clerk or secretary of the political subdivision 8 shall certify an election concerning the coverage of 9 emergency telecommunicators, jailors, and emergency medical service personnel as public safety personnel members of the 10 system to the board within ten days after such vote. 11 date in which the political subdivision's election becomes 12 effective shall be the first day of the calendar month 13 specified by such governing body, the first day of the 14 15 calendar month next following receipt by the board of the 16 certification of the election, or the effective date of the political subdivision's becoming an employer, whichever is 17 the latest date. Such election shall not be changed after 18 19 the effective date. If the election is made, the coverage 20 provisions shall be applicable to all past and future 21 employment with the employer by present and future employees. If a political subdivision makes no election 22 23 under this section, no emergency telecommunicator, jailor, 24 or emergency medical service personnel of the political 25 subdivision shall be considered public safety personnel for

- purposes determining a minimum service retirement age as defined in section 70.600.
- 2. If an employer elects to cover emergency
  29 telecommunicators, jailors, and emergency medical service
- 30 personnel as public safety personnel members of the system,
- 31 the employer's contributions shall be correspondingly
- 32 changed effective the same date as the effective date of the
- 33 political subdivision's election.
- 3. The limitation on increases in an employer's
- 35 contributions provided by subsection 6 of section 70.730
- 36 shall not apply to any contribution increase resulting from
- 37 an employer making an election under the provisions of this
- 38 section.
- 39 [4. The provisions of this section shall only apply to
- 40 counties of the third classification and any county of the
- 41 first classification with more than seventy thousand but
- 42 fewer than eighty-three thousand inhabitants and with a city
- 43 of the fourth classification with more than thirteen
- thousand five hundred but fewer than sixteen thousand
- inhabitants as the county seat, and any political
- 46 subdivisions located, in whole or in part, within such
- 47 counties.]"; and
- 48 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
