Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 742, Page 78, Section 376.380, Line 1233,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "376.1240. 1. For purposes of this section, terms  
 4 shall have the same meanings as ascribed to them in section  
 5 376.1350, and the term "prescription contraceptive" shall  
 6 mean a drug or device that requires a prescription and is  
 7 approved by the Food and Drug Administration to prevent  
 8 pregnancy.

9 2. Any health benefit plan delivered, issued for  
 10 delivery, continued, or renewed in this state on or after  
 11 January 1, 2023, that provides coverage for prescription  
 12 contraceptives shall provide coverage to reimburse a health  
 13 care provider or dispensing entity for the dispensing of a  
 14 supply of prescription contraceptives intended to last up to  
 15 one year.

16 3. The coverage required under this section shall not  
 17 be subject to any greater deductible or co-payment than  
 18 other similar health care services provided by the health  
 19 benefit plan."; and

20 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
