14	to enforce the following rights to access public records
15	maintained by school districts and public schools in which
16	their children are enrolled that receive any federal or
17	<pre>state moneys:</pre>
18	(1) The right to know what their minor child is being
19	taught in school including, but not limited to, curricula,
20	books, and other instructional materials;
21	(2) The right to receive information about who is
22	teaching their minor child including, but not limited to,

27	medical or otherwise, concerning their minor child;

33	situations affecting their minor child's safety in school.
34	4. No school district or public school shall require
35	nondisclosure agreements or similar forms for a parent's
36	review of curricula. Each public school or school district
37	shall allow parents to make copies of curriculum documents.
38	5. No school district or public school shall collect
39	any biometric data or other sensitive personal information
40	about a minor child without obtaining written parental
41	consent before collecting such data or information.
42	6. Each school board meeting pertaining to curricula,
43	safety, or other student issues shall be held in public and
