Amend SS/HCS/House Bill No. 2587, Page 66, Section 620.3930, Line 123,

by inserting after all of said line the following: 2 3 "650.570. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Faith Without Fear Act". 4 2. The department of public safety shall distribute to 5 any not-for-profit religious organization a one-time grant 6 7 for the purpose of enhancing physical security, subject to 8 the requirements of this section. No not-for-profit religious organization shall receive more than one grant 9 pursuant to this section. 10 3. Grants distributed under this section shall not 11 exceed seventy-five percent of the total cost of the 12 13 security enhancement. 4. Subject to appropriation, no more than twenty-five 14 15 million dollars shall be distributed under this section and 16 no more than two million five hundred thousand dollars shall be distributed under this section in any fiscal year. No 17 more than fifty thousand dollars shall be distributed to any 18 one not-for-profit religious organization annually. 19 20 5. (1) The department of public safety shall create an on-line application form as part of its website which 21 22 shall be the sole means of applying for grants under this 23 section. Any not-for-profit religious organization seeking a grant under this section shall submit an application to 24 the department using such form on the department's website. 25 The not-for-profit religious organization shall submit 26

- 27 documents showing how it plans to enhance security,
- 28 including plans for how the not-for-profit religious
- 29 organization will cover the remaining twenty-five percent of
- 30 the cost for its security enhancement.
- 31 (2) In assessing the plans of a not-for-profit
- 32 religious organization for covering the remaining twenty-
- five percent of the cost, the department shall only consider
- 34 costs for the following:
- 35 (a) Physical security enhancements;
- 36 (b) Security personnel costs;
- 37 (c) Installation costs;
- (d) Costs related to increased square footage in the
- 39 not-for-profit religious organization's place of business;
- 40 (e) Employee and security training costs;
- 41 (f) New employee salaries; and
- 42 (g) Existing employee salaries due to new security
- 43 duties.
- 44 (3) Any not-for-profit religious organization applying
- 45 for a grant shall submit documentation to the department
- 46 showing how grant funds will be used.
- 47 6. The department shall prescribe the time of filing
- 48 applications and supervise the processing thereof, provided
- 49 that applications shall be accepted by the department
- 50 beginning October 1, 2022.
- 7. The department shall select qualified recipients to
- 52 receive grants and determine the manner and method of
- payment to the recipients.
- 8. Any not-for-profit religious organization who
- 55 receives a grant pursuant to this section shall submit
- 56 documentation to the department no later than one year after
- 57 the distribution showing how the grant funds were spent.
- 58 9. In the case of a not-for-profit religious
- 59 organization with employees and locations in more than one

60 state, grant funds distributed pursuant to this section 61 shall be used only for locations in Missouri and employees 62 residing in Missouri. 10. For purposes of this section, the terms "enhancing 63 security" and "security enhancement" mean: 64 65 (1) Physical infrastructure security improvement 66 investments; 67 Security risk assessment costs; (2) 68 (3) Costs associated with employee training programs; 69 and 70 (4) Costs associated with upskilling employees with security-related certifications or credentials. 71 72 11. For the purposes of this section, the term "notfor-profit religious organization" means any church, 73 74 synagogue, mosque, or any entity that has or would qualify 75 for federal tax-exempt status as a not-for-profit religious organization under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue 76
