Amend SS/HCS/House Bill No. 2587, Page 39, Section 144.030, Line 632,

2	"260.221. 1. As used in this section, the following
3	terms mean:
4	(1) "Processed recycled asphalt shingles", recycled
5	asphalt shingles that do not contain extraneous metals,
6	glass, rubber, nails, soil, brick, tars, paper, wood, and
7	plastics and that have been reduced in size to produce a
8	commercially reasonable usable product. "Processed recycled
9	asphalt shingles" shall also be considered clean fill, as
10	such term is defined in section 260.200;
11	(2) "Recycled asphalt shingles", manufacture waste
12	scrap shingles and post-consumer, tear-off scrap shingles
13	that are accumulated as products for commercial purposes
14	related to recycling or reuse as processed recycled asphalt
15	shingles.
16	2. Processed recycled asphalt shingles may be used for
17	fill, reclamation, and other beneficial purposes without a
18	permit under sections 260.200 to 260.345 if such processed
19	recycled asphalt shingles are inspected for toxic and
20	hazardous substances in accordance with requirements
21	established by the department of natural resources, provided
22	that processed recycled asphalt shingles shall not be used
23	for such purposes within five hundred feet of any lake,
24	river, sink hole, perennial stream, or ephemeral stream, and
25	shall not be used for such purposes below surface level and
26	closer than fifty feet above the water table.

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27	3. This section shall not be construed to authorize
28	the abandonment, accumulation, placement, or storage of
29	recycled asphalt shingles or processed recycled asphalt
30	shingles on any real property without the consent of the
31	real property owner."; and
32	Further amend said bill, page 66, section 620.3930,
33	line 123 by inserting after all of said line the following:
34	"644.060. 1. Processed recycled asphalt shingles, as
35	defined in section 260.221, may be used for fill,
36	reclamation, and other beneficial purposes without a permit
37	under sections 644.006 to 644.141 if such processed recycled
38	asphalt shingles are inspected for toxic and hazardous
39	substances in accordance with requirements established by
40	the department of natural resources, provided that processed
41	recycled asphalt shingles shall not be used for such
42	purposes within five hundred feet of any lake, river, sink
43	hole, perennial stream, or ephemeral stream, and shall not
44	be used for such purposes below surface level and closer
45	than fifty feet above the water table.
46	2. This section shall not be construed to authorize
47	the abandonment, accumulation, placement, or storage of
48	recycled asphalt shingles or processed recycled asphalt
49	shingles on any real property without the consent of the
50	real property owner."
51	Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.

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
