Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 9 (b) In which there is a charter school or a middle
- school or junior high school serving students in grades six
- 11 to eight or a charter school or a high school serving
- 12 students in grades nine to twelve.
- Beginning July 1, 2023, each charter school and
- 14 public school district shall provide period products in the
- 15 restrooms of each of the charter school's or district's
- 16 school buildings.
- 3. Each charter school and public school district
- 18 shall provide period products at no charge to students. The

20 from funds appropriated to the department of elementary and

21 secondary education for that specific purpose.
