AN ACT

To amend chapter 385, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to air ambulance services, with an effective date.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 385, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 385.500, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 385.500. 1. As used in this section, the following
- 2 terms shall mean:
- 3 (1) "Air ambulance membership product", an agreement
- 4 to pay a subscription or otherwise make prospective payment
- 5 for provision of air ambulance services to a consumer. Such
- 6 term shall not include an agreement between an air ambulance
- 7 service provider and a facility, as such term is defined in
- 8 section 376.1350;
- 9 (2) "Air ambulance services", medical transport or
- 10 emergency services provided by an entity regulated by the
- 11 Federal Aviation Administration;
- 12 (3) "Air ambulance service provider", an entity that
- 13 provides air ambulance services;
- 14 (4) "Consumer", a natural person who is a beneficiary
- of an air ambulance membership product;
- 16 (5) "Emergency service", the same meaning as is
- ascribed to such term in section 376.1350.

- 18 2. In situations where an air ambulance service
- 19 provider provides air ambulance services to a consumer of an
- 20 air ambulance membership product sold by that air ambulance
- 21 service provider, the air ambulance membership product shall
- 22 cover the transport and emergency services in full, and the
- 23 air ambulance service provider shall not bill or accept
- 24 payment from any other insurance product for the transport
- or emergency services, including but not limited to:
- 26 (1) Health benefit plans, as defined in section
- 27 376.1350;
- 28 (2) Employer-provided health insurance regulated under
- 29 the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as
- 30 amended;
- 31 (3) Medicare or Medicare advantage plans;
- 32 (4) MO HealthNet;
- 33 (5) Workers' compensation;
- 34 (6) The Missouri consolidated health care plan
- 35 established in chapter 103; or
- 36 (7) Any other insurance product at the discretion of
- 37 the department of commerce and insurance.
- 38 3. Air ambulance membership products shall be
- 39 considered insurance for purposes of enforcement of this
- 40 section by the director of the department of commerce and
- 41 insurance under chapter 374.
- 42 4. If any provision of this section or the application
- 43 thereof to anyone or to any circumstance is held invalid,
- 44 the remainder of this section and the application of such
- 45 provisions to others or other circumstances shall not be
- 46 affected thereby.

Section B. The enactment of section 385.500 of this

2 act shall become effective on August 28, 2023.
