AN ACT

To amend chapter 226, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to transportation funding.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 226, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
2 one new section, to be known as section 226.235, to read as
3 follows:

226.235. 1. There is hereby created in the state
2 treasury the "Transportation Accountability Fund", which
3 shall consist of general revenue appropriated by the general
4 assembly for highway system uses and purposes, other than
5 moneys appropriated for the payment of principal and
6 interest on outstanding bonds. The state treasurer shall be
7 custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170
8 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements.
9 The fund shall be a dedicated fund and money in the fund
10 shall be used solely by the department of transportation for
11 highway system uses and purposes.

12 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
13 contrary, no disbursements shall be made from the fund at
14 any time the department of transportation employs more than
15 four thousand five hundred employees.

16 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to
17 the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of

18 the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general
19 revenue fund.

20 4. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund
21 in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any
22 interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be
23 credited to the fund.
