AN ACT

To repeal sections 50.815 and 50.820, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to county financial statements.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 50.815 and 50.820, RSMo, are repealed

- 2 and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as
- 3 sections 50.815 and 50.820, to read as follows:
 - 50.815. 1. On or before [the first Monday in March]
- 2 June thirtieth of each year, the county commission of each
- 3 county of the first class not having a charter form of
- 4 government shall, with the assistance of the county clerk,
- 5 prepare and publish in some newspaper of general circulation
- 6 published in the county a financial statement of the county
- 7 for the year ending the preceding December thirty-first.
- 8 2. The financial statement shall show at least the
- 9 following:
- 10 (1) A summary of the receipts of each fund of the
- 11 county for the year;
- 12 (2) A summary of the disbursements and transfers of
- 13 each fund of the county for the year;
- 14 (3) A statement of the cash balance at the beginning
- 15 and at the end of the year for each fund of the county;
- 16 (4) A summary of delinquent taxes and other due bills
- 17 for each fund of the county;

EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

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18 (5) A summary of warrants of each fund of the county 19 outstanding at the end of the year;

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- 20 (6) A statement of bonded indebtedness, if any, at the 21 beginning and at the end of the year for each fund of the 22 county; and
- (7) A statement of the tax levies of each fund of thecounty for the year.
- 25 The financial statement need not show specific disbursements, warrants issued, or the names of specific 26 27 payees, but every individual warrant, voucher, receipt, court order and all other items, records, documents and 28 other information which are not specifically required to be 29 30 retained by the officer having initial charge thereof and which would be required to be included in or to construct a 31 financial statement in the form prescribed for other 32 counties by section 50.800 shall be filed on or before the 33 34 date of publication of the financial statement prescribed by subsection 1 in the office of the county clerk, and the 35 36 county clerk shall preserve the same, and shall cause the same to be available for inspection during normal business 37 hours on the request of any person, for a period of five 38 years following the date of filing in his office, after 39 which five-year period these records may be disposed of 40 41 according to law unless they are the subject of a legal suit pending at the expiration of that period. 42
- 43 4. At the end of the financial statement, each
 44 commissioner of the county commission and the county clerk
 45 shall sign and append the following certificate:

5. Any person falsely certifying to any fact covered by the certificate is liable on his bond and is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than two hundred dollars or more than one thousand dollars, or by confinement in the county jail for a period of not less than thirty days nor more than six months, or by both such fine and confinement. Any person charged with preparing the financial report who willfully or knowingly makes a false report of any record is, in addition to the penalties otherwise provided for in this section, guilty of a felony, and upon conviction thereof shall be

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sentenced to imprisonment by the division of corrections for a term of not less than two years nor more than five years.

- 6. The provisions of sections 50.800 and 50.810 do not apply to counties of the first class not having a charter form of government, except as provided in subsection 3 of this section.
- The statement required by section 50.815 50.820. 1. 2 shall be set in the standard column width measure which will 3 take the least space and the publisher shall file two proofs 4 of publication with the county commission and the commission shall forward one proof to the state auditor and shall file 5 the other in the office of the commission. The county 6 7 commission shall not pay the publisher until proof of publication is filed with the commission and the state 8 9 auditor notifies the commission that proof of publication 10 has been received and that it complies with the requirements 11 of this section.
- 2. The statement shall be spread on the record of the commission and for this purpose the publisher shall be required to furnish the commission with at least two copies of the statement which may be pasted on the record.
- The state auditor shall notify the county treasurer 16 immediately of the receipt of the proof of publication of 17 18 the statement. After the first day of [April] July of each year the county treasurer shall not pay or enter for protest 19 20 any warrant for the pay of any of the county commission until notice is received from the state auditor that the 21 required proof of publication has been filed. Any county 22 23 treasurer paying or entering for protest any warrant for any commissioner of the county commission prior to the receipt 24 of such notice from the state auditor shall be liable 25 therefor on his official bond. 26

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The state auditor shall prepare sample forms for 27 financial statements required by section 50.815 and shall 28 mail the same to the county clerk of each county of the 29 first class not having a charter form of government in this 30 state, but failure of the auditor to supply such forms shall 31 32 not in any way excuse any person from the performance of any duty imposed by this section or by section 50.815. If any 33 county officer fails, neglects, or refuses to comply with 34 35 the provisions of this section or section 50.815 he shall, in addition to other penalties provided by law, be liable on 36 his official bond for dereliction of duty. 37

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
