AN ACT

To repeal section 195.815, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to medical marijuana facilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 195.815, RSMo, is repealed and one new
2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 195.815,
3 to read as follows:

195.815. 1. The department of health and senior
2 services shall require all [officers, managers, contractors,
3 employees, and other support staff of licensed or certified]
4 **employees, contractors, owners, and volunteers of** medical
5 marijuana facilities[, and all owners of such medical
6 marijuana facilities who will have access to the facilities
7 or to the facilities' medical marijuana,] to submit
8 fingerprints to the Missouri state highway patrol for the
9 purpose of conducting a state and federal fingerprint-based
10 criminal background check.

11 2. The department may require that such fingerprint
12 submissions be made as part of a medical marijuana facility
13 application [for licensure or certification], a medical
14 marijuana facility **renewal** application [for renewal of
15 licensure or certification], and an individual's application
16 for **licensure and issuance of** an identification card
17 authorizing that individual to be an [owner, officer,
18 manager, contractor, employee, or other support staff]

EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

19 **employee, contractor, owner, or volunteer** of a medical
20 marijuana facility.

21 3. Fingerprint cards and any required fees shall be
22 sent to the Missouri state highway patrol's central
23 repository. The fingerprints shall be used for searching
24 the state criminal records repository and shall also be
25 forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a
26 federal criminal records search under section 43.540. The
27 Missouri state highway patrol shall notify the department of
28 any criminal history record information or lack of criminal
29 history record information discovered on the individual.
30 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 610.120 to the
31 contrary, all records related to any criminal history
32 information discovered shall be accessible and available to
33 the department.

34 4. As used in this section, the following words shall
35 mean:

36 (1) "Employee", [any] a person performing work or
37 service of any kind or character for hire in a medical
38 marijuana facility;

39 (2) "Contractor", a person performing work or service
40 of any kind for a medical marijuana facility pursuant to a
41 contract with that facility;

42 (3) "Medical marijuana facility", an entity licensed
43 or certified by the department of health and senior
44 services[, or its successor agency,] to acquire, cultivate,
45 process, manufacture, test, store, sell, transport, or
46 deliver medical marijuana;

47 [(3) "Other support staff", any person performing work
48 or service of any kind or character, other than employees,
49 on behalf of a medical marijuana facility if such a person

50 would have access to the medical marijuana facility or its
51 medical marijuana or related equipment or supplies.]

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
