

# SENATE AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_

Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 30, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 4,

2 by striking "sports wagering" and inserting in lieu thereof  
3 the following: "gaming"; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 6, Section 313.813, line  
5 12, by inserting after all of said line the following:

6 "313.820. 1. An excursion boat licensee shall pay to  
7 the commission an admission fee of [two] four dollars for  
8 each person embarking on an excursion gambling boat with a  
9 ticket of admission, with such amount adjusted annually for  
10 inflation. [One dollar] One-half of such fee shall be  
11 deposited to the credit of the gaming commission fund as  
12 authorized pursuant to section 313.835, and [one dollar] one-  
13 half of such fee shall not be considered state funds and  
14 shall be paid to the home dock city or county. Subject to  
15 appropriation, one cent of such fee deposited to the credit  
16 of the gaming commission fund may be deposited to the credit  
17 of the compulsive gamblers fund created pursuant to the  
18 provisions of section 313.842. Nothing in this section shall  
19 preclude any licensee from charging any amount deemed  
20 necessary for a ticket of admission to any person embarking  
21 on an excursion gambling boat. If tickets are issued which  
22 are good for more than one excursion, the admission fee  
23 shall be paid to the commission for each person using the  
24 ticket on each excursion that the ticket is used. If free  
25 passes or complimentary admission tickets are issued, the  
26 excursion boat licensee shall pay to the commission the same

27 fee upon these passes or complimentary tickets as if they  
28 were sold at the regular and usual admission rate; however,  
29 the excursion boat licensee may issue fee-free passes to  
30 actual and necessary officials and employees of the licensee  
31 or other persons actually working on the excursion gambling  
32 boat. The issuance of fee-free passes is subject to the  
33 rules of the commission, and a list of all persons to whom  
34 the fee-free passes are issued shall be filed with the  
35 commission.

36 2. All licensees are subject to all income taxes,  
37 sales taxes, earnings taxes, use taxes, property taxes or  
38 any other tax or fee now or hereafter lawfully levied by any  
39 political subdivision; however, no other license tax, permit  
40 tax, occupation tax, excursion fee, or taxes or fees shall  
41 be imposed, levied or assessed exclusively upon licensees by  
42 a political subdivision. All state taxes not connected  
43 directly to gambling games shall be collected by the  
44 department of revenue. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
45 section 32.057 to the contrary, the department of revenue  
46 may furnish and the commission may receive tax information  
47 to determine if applicants or licensees are complying with  
48 the tax laws of this state; however, any tax information  
49 acquired by the commission shall not become public record  
50 and shall be used exclusively for commission business.";

51 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
