AN ACT

To repeal section 260.209, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to solid waste disposal.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 260.209, RSMo, is repealed and one new
2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 260.209,
3 to read as follows:

260.209. 1. Any district, city or county that
2 acquires real or personal property in another incorporated
3 city or in an unincorporated area of a county, by
4 condemnation, purchase, gift, lease, sale or otherwise to
5 establish, operate, maintain, construct, improve, own,
6 control or regulate waste to energy plants, incinerators,
7 recycling centers, processing plants, composting areas,
8 transfer stations, solid waste processing facilities, solid
9 waste disposal area, treatment facilities, storage
10 facilities, or other management areas, shall be subject to
11 and comply with any and all zoning ordinances of the city in
12 which such acquisition was made or if such acquisition is
13 located within an unincorporated area of a county, then such
14 district, city or county making the acquisition shall be
15 subject to and comply with all zoning requirements and
16 ordinances of the county in which the acquisition was made.

17 2. After August 28, 1999, no political subdivision
18 shall be granted any permit, license, or grant of authority

19 to own, operate or control any land outside its boundaries
20 and used for any purpose subject to regulation pursuant to
21 sections 260.200 to 260.345 without meeting the zoning
22 requirements of the political subdivision in which the land
23 is located in effect on the date of application **for a**
24 **preliminary site investigation.**

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
