Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill Nos. 1168 & 810, Page 1, Section A, Line 4,

by inserting after all of said line the following: 2 3 "188.017. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Right to Life of the Unborn Child Act". 4 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the 5 contrary, no abortion shall be performed or induced upon a 6 7 woman, except in cases of medical emergency or in cases where the woman is twelve years old or younger. Any person 8 9 who knowingly performs or induces an abortion of an unborn child in violation of this subsection shall be quilty of a 10 class B felony, as well as subject to suspension or 11 12 revocation of his or her professional license by his or her professional licensing board. A woman upon whom an abortion 13 is performed or induced in violation of this subsection 14 15 shall not be prosecuted for a conspiracy to violate the provisions of this subsection. 16

3. It shall be an affirmative defense for any person 17 alleged to have violated the provisions of subsection 2 of 18 this section that the person performed or induced an 19 abortion because of a medical emergency. The defendant 20 shall have the burden of persuasion that the defense is more 21 22 probably true than not.

23 4. The enactment of this section shall only become effective upon notification to the revisor of statutes by an 24 25 opinion by the attorney general of Missouri, a proclamation

26 by the governor of Missouri, or the adoption of a concurrent 27 resolution by the Missouri general assembly that:

(1) The United States Supreme Court has overruled, in
whole or in part, Roe v. Wade, 410 U.S. 113 (1973),
restoring or granting to the state of Missouri the authority
to regulate abortion to the extent set forth in this
section, and that as a result, it is reasonably probable
that this section would be upheld by the court as
constitutional;

35 (2) An amendment to the Constitution of the United
36 States has been adopted that has the effect of restoring or
37 granting to the state of Missouri the authority to regulate
38 abortion to the extent set forth in this section; or

39 (3) The United States Congress has enacted a law that
40 has the effect of restoring or granting to the state of
41 Missouri the authority to regulate abortion to the extent
42 set forth in this section."; and

43 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
