AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school meals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 167.204, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 167.204. 1. This section shall be known and may be
- 2 cited as the "Missouri School Meals Act".
- 3 2. As used in this section, the term "school" shall
- 4 mean any school district; public school, including a charter
- 5 school; or private, religious, or parochial school that
- 6 participates in the National School Lunch Program or
- 7 successive program but does not participate in the USDA
- 8 Community Eligibility Option.
- 9 3. A school shall provide a free lunch to any student
- 10 who has been approved to receive a reduced price lunch under
- 11 the USDA National School Lunch Program. Subject to
- 12 appropriation, the state board of education shall reimburse
- 13 schools the difference between the total cost of each lunch
- 14 provided under this subsection and the federal reimbursement
- 15 rate for each lunch provided under this subsection.
- 16 4. A school shall determine which students may be
- 17 eligible for free or reduced price lunch through the
- 18 National School Lunch Program and shall provide information

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and assistance to parents and guardians of such students for purposes of filling out an application.

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- 5. A school shall not publicly identify or otherwise stigmatize a student who is or may be eligible for free or reduced price lunch. A student's application for the National School Lunch Program shall be used only for federal reimbursement and for state aid calculations under chapter 163.
- 27 6. (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury 28 the "School Meals Fund", which shall consist of moneys 29 appropriated by the general assembly for the purposes of 30 implementing the provisions of this section. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance 31 32 with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may 33 approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund 34 and money in the fund shall be used solely by the state board of education for the purposes of reimbursing schools 35 as provided in subsection 3 of this section. 36
- 37 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 38 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end 39 of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the 40 general revenue fund.
 - (3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.
 - 7. The state board of education shall promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation of this section.

 Such rules shall include the process by which schools may apply for reimbursement as provided in subsection 3 of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the

- 52 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the
- 53 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section
- 54 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and
- if any of the powers vested with the general assembly
- 56 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective
- 57 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently
- 58 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking
- 59 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28,
- 60 2024, shall be invalid and void.

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
