AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to delivery of intoxicating liquor.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 311.187, to read as follows:

311.187. (1) Any place of business licensed in accordance with section 311.200 may deliver intoxicating liquor to a consumer away from the licensed business premises by utilizing a common carrier, an employee of the retailer, or by a third-party assigned agent of the retailer.
