## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 160.527, RSMo, relating to health and family education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 160.527, RSMo, is repealed, to read as

## 2 follows:

**[**160.527. The one-half unit of credit 1. in health education required by the state board 2 of education shall be renamed "Health and Family 3 Education" for the 2024-25 school year and all subsequent school years. The state board of education shall 7 convene a work group to develop and recommend 8 academic performance standards relating to the 9 one-half unit of credit of health and family 10 education required by the board. The work group 11 shall include, but not be limited to, educators 12 providing instruction in health education and 13 family and consumer science in grades nine to 14 twelve, representatives from the department of 15 elementary and secondary education, and 16 nonprofit organizations that focus on public 17 health, parenting, and social services. 18 work group shall develop written curriculum 19 frameworks relating to health and family 20 education with an emphasis on behavioral health relating to the causes of morbidity and 21 22 mortality of youth, chronic disease management, 23 and parenting skills associated with optimal 24 family health over a lifetime that may be used 25 by school districts. The state board of education shall 27 adopt and implement academic performance standards relating to health and family education for the 2024-25 school year and all 28 29 subsequent school years. 30 31 The requirements of section 160.514 32 shall not apply to this section.
