AN ACT

To repeal section 256.410, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the release of certain confidential information by the division of geology and land survey, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

	Section A. Section 256.410, RSMo, is repealed and one new
2	section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 256.410,
3	to read as follows:
	256.410. 1. No major water user shall withdraw or
2	divert water from any water source without filing an
3	official registration document with the division. The
4	registration document shall set forth:
5	(1) The name and mailing address of the applicant;
6	(2) The name, if any, and location of the water source;
7	(3) The type of water source (such as well, lake or
8	stream);
9	(4) The point in the water source from which it is
10	proposed to withdraw or divert the water;
11	(5) The name, location, and acreage of the lands or
12	other application to which such water is to be diverted;
13	(6) The location and description of the water well,
14	canal, tunnel or pipes and other works or equipment through
15	which the water is to be withdrawn or diverted;
16	(7) The amount in gallons of water withdrawn or
17	diverted on an average day of operation, and the number of

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18 days and the months during the preceding year, when water 19 was diverted;

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20 (8) The total amount in gallons withdrawn or diverted
21 during the preceding year, and the periods of time when such
22 diversion is scheduled during the current year.

The foregoing requirements of this subsection shall not apply to water being pumped from mines and quarries and such water user shall only be required to set forth the quantity pumped from the mine and quarry at each point where it is pumped to the point to discharge and only the name of the stream into which any of the discharge is permitted to flow.

29 2. Withdrawal or diversion of water by major users may continue during the first calendar year after September 28, 30 31 1983, or after the initial date of their operation, at which time a registration document must be filed. The filing 32 period shall extend from January first through March thirty-33 first. Withdrawal or diversion may continue during the 34 filing period. Location data shall be given in terms of 35 section, township and range. 36

Any individually identifiable user information 37 3. obtained by the division from the filed registration 38 39 document, including the user's name, mailing address, and 40 additional contact information, shall remain confidential 41 and shall not be released by the division to the public or 42 disclosed in response to any request, including a records 43 request under chapter 610. Any employee of the division who 44 discloses confidential information shall be subject to 45 disciplinary action by the division and is guilty of a class A misdemeanor. 46

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
