AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to permanent vehicle registration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 301.148, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 301.148. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to
- the contrary, vehicles eligible for registration under this
- 3 chapter may, at the option of the registrant, be registered
- 4 permanently upon the payment of seven times the applicable
- 5 fees required to register the vehicle annually and
- 6 presentation of all documentation otherwise required by law
- 7 to register the vehicle annually.
- 8 2. The permanent plate or plates and registration fees
- 9 are vehicle specific. The plate or plates and the
- 10 registration fees paid are nontransferable and
- 11 nonrefundable, except those covered under the provisions of
- 12 section 301.442. Upon the transfer of the title to any
- 13 vehicle registered in accordance with this section, the
- 14 registration shall be cancelled and the license plates
- issued therefor shall be returned to the director of revenue.
- 3. As used in this section, the term "fees" shall
- 17 include:

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18 (1) Fees for registering the vehicle in accordance 19 with this chapter;

- (2) Emblem-use authorization fees, contributions, or donations as specified in this chapter for the issuance of 22 special license plates, which shall be paid to the 23 organization issuing the emblem use authorization statement for the plate or plates unless otherwise specified by law; 24 25 and
- 26 (3) Fees collected as compensation for department of 27 revenue fee offices under section 136.055, which shall be 28 paid to the fee office. Fee offices are hereby authorized 29 to collect a fee as compensation in full and for all 30 services rendered, on the basis specified in this section.
 - 4. The department of revenue may issue a distinctive registration tab or tabs indicating a vehicle has been permanently registered as specified in this section.
 - 5. The department of revenue may promulgate rules as necessary for the implementation of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2024, shall be invalid and void.
