AN ACT

To amend chapter 192, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to nonopioid alternatives.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 192, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 192.975, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 192.975. 1. The department of health and senior
- 2 services shall develop and publish on its website an
- 3 educational pamphlet regarding the use of nonopioid
- 4 alternatives for the treatment of acute, subacute, and
- 5 chronic pain. The pamphlet shall conform with the most
- 6 current clinical practice guidelines for prescribing opioids
- 7 for pain from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
- 8 and may be updated as needed. The information in the
- 9 pamphlet shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- 10 (1) Information on available nonopioid alternatives
- 11 for the treatment of pain, including pharmacological and
- 12 nonpharmacological treatments; and
- 13 (2) The advantages and disadvantages of the use of
- 14 nonopioid alternatives.
- 15 2. No later than January 1, 2025, and every two years
- thereafter, the department shall distribute the most updated
- 17 version of the educational pamphlet to local public health
- 18 agencies and associations representing the state's federally
