Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 61, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 3,

2 by striking "reciprocity for"; and

3 Further amend said bill, page 8, section 324.009, line
4 141, by inserting after all of said line the following:

5 "345.050. To be eligible for licensure by the board by
6 examination, each applicant shall submit the application fee
7 and shall furnish evidence of such person's current
8 competence and shall:

9 (1) Hold a master's or a doctoral degree from a
10 program that was awarded "accreditation candidate" status or
11 is accredited by the Council on Academic Accreditation of
12 the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association or other
13 accrediting agency approved by the board in the area in
14 which licensure is sought;

15 (2) Submit official transcripts from one or more
16 accredited colleges or universities presenting evidence of
17 the completion of course work and clinical practicum
18 requirements equivalent to that required by the Council on
19 Academic Accreditation of the American Speech-Language-
20 Hearing Association or other accrediting agency approved by
21 the board;

22 (3) Present written evidence of completion of a
23 clinical fellowship from supervisors. The experience
24 required by this subdivision shall follow the completion of
25 the requirements of subdivisions (1) and (2) of this
26 section. This period of employment shall be under the

27 direct supervision of a [person who is licensed by the state
28 of Missouri in the profession in which the applicant seeks
29 to be] licensed speech-language pathologist in good
30 standing. Persons applying with an audiology clinical
31 doctoral degree are exempt from this provision; and
32 (4) Pass an examination promulgated or approved by the
33 board. The board shall determine the subject and scope of
34 the examinations."; and
35 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
