Amend SS/HCS/House Bill Nos. 737 & 486, Page 43, Section 210.762, Line 44,

by inserting after all of said line the following: 2 3 "210.1012. 1. There is hereby created a statewide program called the "Amber Alert System" referred to in this 4 section as the "system" to aid in the identification and 5 location of an abducted child or an abducted or missing 6 7 African American youth. 8 2. For the purposes of this section, the following 9 terms mean: (1) "Abducted child" [means], a child whose 10 whereabouts are unknown and who is: 11 [(1)] (a) Less than eighteen years of age and 12 reasonably believed to be the victim of the crime of 13 kidnapping or kidnapping in the first degree as defined by 14 15 section 565.110 as determined by local law enforcement; 16 [(2)] (b) Reasonably believed to be the victim of the crime of child kidnapping as defined by section 565.115 as 17 determined by local law enforcement; or 18 19 [(3)] (c) Less than eighteen years of age and at least fourteen years of age and who, if under the age of fourteen, 20 21 would otherwise be reasonably believed to be a victim of 22 child kidnapping as defined by section 565.115 as determined 23 by local law enforcement; (2) "Abducted or missing African American youth", an 24 African American individual whose whereabouts are unknown 25 26 and who is:

- 27 <u>(a) Less than eighteen years of age and reasonably</u>
  28 believed to be the victim of the offense of kidnapping or
- 29 kidnapping in the first degree as defined by section 565.110
- 30 as determined by local law enforcement;
- 31 (b) Reasonably believed to be the victim of the
- 32 offense of child kidnapping as defined by section 565.115 as
- 33 determined by local law enforcement;
- 34 (c) Less than eighteen years of age and at least
- fourteen years of age and who, if under the age of fourteen,
- 36 would otherwise be reasonably believed to be a victim of
- 37 child kidnapping as defined by section 565.115 as determined
- 38 by local law enforcement; or
- 39 (d) Reasonably believed to be a victim of an offense
- 40 of trafficking pursuant to sections 566.206, 566.209,
- 41 566.210, or 566.211.
- 42 3. The department of public safety shall develop
- 43 regions to provide the system. The department of public
- 44 safety shall coordinate local law enforcement agencies and
- 45 public commercial television and radio broadcasters to
- 46 provide an effective system. In the event that a local law
- 47 enforcement agency opts not to set up a system and an
- 48 abduction occurs within the jurisdiction, it shall notify
- 49 the department of public safety who will notify local media
- 50 in the region.
- 51 4. The Amber alert system shall include all state
- 52 agencies capable of providing urgent and timely information
- 53 to the public together with broadcasters and other private
- 54 entities that volunteer to participate in the dissemination
- of urgent public information. At a minimum, the Amber alert
- 56 system shall include the department of public safety,
- 57 highway patrol, department of transportation, department of
- 58 health and senior services, and Missouri lottery.

- 59 5. The department of public safety shall have the 60 authority to notify other regions upon verification that the 61 criteria established by the oversight committee has been met.
- 6. Participation in an Amber alert system is entirely 63 at the option of local law enforcement agencies and 64 federally licensed radio and television broadcasters.
- 7. Any person who knowingly makes a false report that triggers an alert pursuant to this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 8. The department of public safety shall not
  discriminate against any person because of race, color,
  religion, national origin, ancestry, sex, disability, or
  familial status when coordinating with local law enforcement
  agencies and public commercial television and radio
  broadcasters to provide an effective system."; and
