Amend SS/House Bill No. 419, Page 3, Section 173.1153, Line 41,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "173.1352. 1. As used in this section, the following  
4 terms mean:

5 (1) "Advanced placement examination", any examination  
6 administered through the College Board's Advanced Placement  
7 Program (AP);

8 (2) "Institution", any in-state public community  
9 college, college, or university that offers postsecondary  
10 freshman-level courses;

11 (3) "International baccalaureate examination", any  
12 examination for assessment purposes administered through the  
13 International Baccalaureate Organization at the end of the  
14 International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

15 2. (1) Each institution shall adopt and implement a  
16 policy to grant undergraduate course credit to entering  
17 freshman students for each advanced placement examination  
18 upon which such student achieves a score of three or higher,  
19 or each international baccalaureate examination for an  
20 international baccalaureate diploma programme course upon  
21 which such student achieves a score of four or higher, for  
22 any similarly correlated course offered by the institution  
23 at the time of such student's acceptance into the  
24 institution.

25 (2) In the policy, the institution shall:

26           (a) Establish the institution's conditions for  
27 granting course credit; and

28           (b) Identify the specific course credit or other  
29 academic requirements of the institution, including the  
30 number of semester credit hours or other course credit, that  
31 the institution will grant to a student who achieves  
32 required scores on advanced placement examinations or  
33 international baccalaureate examinations.

34           3. On request of an applicant for admission as an  
35 entering freshman, and based on information provided by the  
36 applicant, an institution shall determine and notify the  
37 applicant regarding:

38           (1) The amount and type of any course credit that  
39 would be granted to the applicant under the policy; and

40           (2) Any other academic requirement that the applicant  
41 would satisfy under the policy."; and

42           Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
