Amend SA# SS/HCS#2/House Bill Nos. 567, et al, Page 2, Section 290.502, Line 57,

2 by inserting after "subsections." the following:

3 "290.525. Any employer who hinders the director in the  
 4 performance of his duties in the enforcement of sections  
 5 290.500 to 290.530 by any of the following acts is guilty of  
 6 a class **[C]** A misdemeanor:

7 (1) Refusing to admit the director to any place of  
 8 employment;

9 (2) Failing to make, keep and preserve any records as  
 10 required under the provisions of sections 290.500 to 290.530;

11 (3) Falsifying any record required under the  
 12 provisions of sections 290.500 to 290.530;

13 (4) Refusing to make any record required under the  
 14 provisions of sections 290.500 to 290.530 accessible to the  
 15 director;

16 (5) Refusing to furnish a sworn statement of any  
 17 record required under the provisions of sections 290.500 to  
 18 290.530 or any other information required for the proper  
 19 enforcement of sections 290.500 to 290.530 to the director  
 20 upon demand;

21 (6) Failing to post a summary of sections 290.500 to  
 22 290.530 or a copy of any applicable regulation as required;

23           (7) Discharging or in any other manner discriminating  
24 against any employee who has notified the director that he  
25 has not been paid wages in accordance with the provisions of  
26 sections 290.500 to 290.530, or who has caused to be  
27 instituted any proceeding under or related to sections  
28 290.500 to 290.530, or who has testified or is about to  
29 testify in any such proceeding;

30           (8) Paying or agreeing to pay wages at a rate less  
31 than the rate applicable under sections 290.500 to 290.530.  
32 Payment at such rate for any week or portion of a week  
33 constitutes a separate offense as to each employee;

34           (9) Otherwise violating any provisions of sections  
35 290.500 to 290.530.

36 Each day of violation constitutes a separate offense."; and

37 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly
